ABOUT THE ROLE

We are seeking a skilled DevOps Engineer to join our client's infrastructure and platform team in Dublin. You will design, build, and maintain the CI/CD pipelines, cloud infrastructure, and observability systems that underpin mission-critical medical software. In a regulated healthcare environment, reliability, security, and compliance are non-negotiable — your work will directly support systems used in patient care.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design, implement, and maintain CI/CD pipelines using tools such as GitHub Actions, GitLab CI, or Jenkins.
- Manage and optimise cloud infrastructure on AWS and/or Azure, with a strong focus on high availability and disaster recovery.
- Containerise and orchestrate services using Docker and Kubernetes.
- Implement infrastructure-as-code using Terraform or Pulumi; enforce GitOps practices across the team.
- Monitor system health, define SLOs/SLAs, and build alerting/observability pipelines using tools such as Prometheus, Grafana, and Datadog.
- Collaborate with software and QA teams to ensure environments are consistent across dev, staging, and production.
- Support compliance requirements including HIPAA, GDPR, and ISO 13485 as they relate to infrastructure and data handling.
- Participate in on-call rotations and incident response for production systems.

REQUIREMENTS

- 3–5 years of DevOps or infrastructure engineering experience.
- Strong hands-on experience with AWS and/or Azure cloud services.
- Proficiency with container orchestration — Kubernetes is essential.
- Solid scripting skills in Bash and Python.
- Experience with Terraform or equivalent IaC tooling.
- Understanding of security best practices for cloud environments (IAM, secrets management, network segmentation).
- Familiarity with regulated environments (healthcare, finance, or similar) is a significant advantage.
